
Item No. 63.07 : To consider the recommendations of the Committee related to applications received in the Institute for PDF and SRF.

Item No. 63.10 : **To consider the recommendations of the Ordinance Review Committee.**




It seems that lot of students are not taking seriously the academic calendar specified registration dates and not abiding the same. Looking into the issue the Standing Committee resolved the followings:



- Students who have not deposited their academic certificates (i.e. Migration / Provisional Degree / Passing out certificate) will not be allowed for registration without depositing such documents.





3. The committee discussed the case of Mr. Ram Sumukh Shukla (Reg. No. 2014RAM04), a research scholar in the department of Applied Mechanics. After completion of his first four semesters, he has taken semester leave twice on medical grounds. After joining the institute, he was registered in the 7th semester. Now he is requesting to do his registration in 5th semester discounting the two semesters in which he was on leave. As per clause no. 4.2 of the Ordinances for Doctoral Programme, any student who is on authorized leave shall continue to register in the programme. After discussion, the committee resolved that the candidate's registration should be in the seventh semester and his transcript should mention the leave granted for fifth and sixth semester.
4. It has been observed that large number of students have tendency of not doing the physical registration on due dates at the beginning of odd and even semesters and later on report for late registration. The committee took the cognizance of the issue and in order to discourage the same, it recommends the following:
- (i) Late registration should not be permitted without prior permission from Dean (Academic)/Chairman, Senate and it should be permitted for genuine reasons only.
- (ii) Students allowed for late registration need to pay the late registration fee of Rs. 2500/- during the permitted duration of late registration (as per academic calendar). Beyond this if any student is permitted, he/she needs to pay fine of Rs. 500/- per day in addition to Rs. 2500/- late fee.
- (iii) Students who do not pay the institute fee till due date (last date of online registration as per academic calendar) will be required to pay the late fee payment charge of Rs. 2500/- till notified date of late registration in addition to late fee/late fine mentioned in point (ii) above.
- (iv) No registration should be allowed beyond the due date for late registration without permission of Chairman Senate/Director.



Guidelines for Institute Faculty for Supervising / Co-supervising students of other Institute / University


1. In the Guidelines, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) "Institute" means Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad (MNNIT Allahabad).
 - (b) "Parent Institute / University" means the Institute in which the Research Scholar is enrolled for the degree program.
 - (c) "Supervisor / Co-supervisor" means Regular Faculty of MNNIT Allahabad.
 - (d) "Research Scholars" means Research Scholars having enrollment in other Institute / University.

2. The Faculty of MNNIT Allahabad who wish to Supervise / Co-supervise students of other Institute / University shall abide the following:
 - (a) Supervisor / Co-Supervisor shall not Supervise/Co-supervise more than two Research Scholars. Preferably, these two Research Scholars shall be from different Parent Institute/University.
 - (b) The Research Scholar need to be stationed and/or working within Allahabad Development Authority (ADA) jurisdiction.
 - (c) The Research Scholar need to be enrolled in any of the following category of Institutions.
 - **Category – I Institutions:**
 - IITs / NITs / IISc / IISERs / IIMs / IIITs/IIEST Shibpur.
 - **Category – II Institutions:**
 - Other Centrally funded Technical Institutions.
 - State funded Technical Institutions.
 - **Category – III Institutions:** Any other Institutions appearing within top 100 rank of NIRF ranking published by MHRD in last two years.

- (d) The Research Scholar shall submit Rs. 10,000/- per semester in Institute as supervision fee in lieu of facilitating the Institute faculty as his/ her Supervisor/Co-supervisor. This fee will include fee for utilisation of research facilities such as labs, library, Software's etc. to the Research Scholars on Saturdays only.
- (e) Charges mentioned at point No. 2(d) would be raised by 20% every two year.
- (f) Supervisor / Co-supervisor shall preferably facilitate the Research Scholar on Saturdays.
- (g) The registration record of these Research Scholars would be maintained at the Office of Dean(Academic) and concerned departments.
- (h) Supervisor/Co-supervisor would be entitled for all the IPR points generated through this activity.
- (i) In case of Research Scholar belonging to a foreign university then a separate MoU need to be signed with the said university.

In case the Supervisor / Co-Supervisor is required to travel to Parent Institute, then that shall be considered under Special Casual leave. The Institute shall not borne any expense incurred by the Supervisor / Co-Supervisor in this regard.

All the departments/cell/school have provided inputs which are compiled and attached as ANNEXURE-1 with this minutes.

The office of the Dean (Academic) has sent a reminder letter to those Departments who had not provided their inputs on the Examination Reforms as per the recommendation of AICTE vide letter No. 1224/Acad./2018-19 dated March 28, 2019 to provide their inputs on the same.

Based on the inputs received from different departments following are the resolutions / recommendations of the Committee:

The MHRD has suggested implementing the examination reforms proposed by AICTE from A.Y. 2018-19. These examination reforms will ensure the outcome based learning and development of higher-order abilities and professional skills in the students. The reforms suggest the assessment strategies for an outcome-based education system. It provides the possible ways to improve the structure and quality of assessments by the inclusion of higher-order abilities and professional skills' assessment. After going through the inputs received from different departments and deliberations, the committee feels that the Institute is already following certain parts of the proposed reforms and supports in-principle to implement the remaining examination reforms in the future. The specific observations of the committee are as follows:

1. The members observed that the programme outcomes (POs) have already been clearly defined for our UG/PG programmes and mapped to various graduate attributes like basic knowledge, problem analysis, investigation of complex problems, modern tools usage, ethics that helps in outcome-based assessment. The assessment of higher order abilities and professional skills is

following Bloom's taxonomy to a larger extent. Departments assess, students through assignment, quizzes, fixed hour examinations as well as through course projects, mini/minor projects, internship experience, and final year projects.

2. The Course outcomes for different courses may be different; thus their best or appropriate evaluation method may be different. It requires a flexible curriculum structure, with the provision of the different component of marks for different subjects where the TA (20 to 40 marks) and examination (80 to 60 marks) components may be varied within a range and can be notified by the course coordinator at the beginning of the semester. It also requires a decentralized evaluation (examination) system with flexible grading (mark splitting) scheme.
3. The committee believes that a faculty member needs to put more effort into designing the question paper and evaluation of different components for individual students besides maintaining huge records for the same. In order to do that individual faculty should not be given more than one course per semester (Either PG or UG course only). The assessment also demands more time per student, which requires the reduction in the existing class size and better Infrastructure. The current student-teacher ratio and presently available infrastructure at our institute do not support the exact implementation of the suggested reforms in one step rather the same can be done gradually in multiple steps.
4. The academic 'Credit' points for Project work in the B.Tech. final year should be increased in order to encourage project-based learning. The number of theory courses in UG/PG courses and the total credit points required for the award of the degree should be reduced so that the students will be able to devote more time in developing the higher-order abilities and professional skills.
5. The quality of question papers should be monitored as per the guidelines given in the documents by constituting a committee at the department level and one committee at the Institute level. A workshop by experts from institutes like NITTR may be planned for proper training of faculty members on the proposed examination reforms.
6. The committee also felt that in the upcoming end semester examinations, the course coordinator might be asked to send a copy of the syllabus taught (along with COs and other details) to the examination cell. This copy of syllabus may be packed in the EXTRA PAPERS envelope containing five question papers.

A BRIEF REPORT ON
 INPUTS RECEIVED FROM DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS / CELL / SCHOOL
 ON RECOMMENDATIONS FOR EXAMINATION REFORMS OF AICTE

| 1. | Applied Mechanics | <p>Head AMD presented recommendation of AICTE for examination reform to the faculty members present in the meeting for their comments and suggestions. Faculty members discussed on this matter and resolved the following.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Faculty members present in the meeting appreciated the steps taken by MHRD in the direction to improve the examination procedure. Most of the faculty members agreed with reforms proposed in the AICTE documents and coined it as "bigger goal of outcome based education (OBE)". 2. The members also agreed that a few components towards the attainment of QBE such as defining POs, PEOs, CGs and their mapping to POs, and regular revision of curriculum are already been practiced at MNNITA, Prayagraj as well as in the department. 3. Evaluation and assessment component of OBE to achieve the COs and outcomes are largely unimplemented so far. This document presents the guidelines to implement this aspect. 4. MNNITA, Prayagraj may adopt for a flexible grading system as the assessment method proposed in the reforms to test the higher-order abilities of teaching and learning which is difficult to achieve with current grading scheme. 5. A major part of Bloom's taxonomy is followed at MNNITA, Prayagraj however higher components are missing somehow. The open-note/open-book examination is a very good initiative proposed in the reforms and can be implemented at least at PG level initially. 6. A few faculty members suggested to replace the mid-semester examination with term project if required to achieve the course outcome objectives. 7. The COs for different courses, may be different, thus their best or appropriate evaluation method may be different. This requires a flexible curriculum structure, with provision of different component of marks on different category of different subjects. This requires a decentralized evaluation (examination) system with flexible grading (mark splitting) schemes. 8. However, some faculty members also requested to reduce the teaching load to one course per semester including PG or UG course as the implementation of these reforms in the examination pattern will involve extra time and academic efforts. Some faculty members also requested for training for OBE. |

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| 2. | Biotechnology | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The members observed the programme outcomes have already been clearly defined for our UG/PG programmes. The POs have also been mapped to the various graduate attributes like basic knowledge, Problem Analysis, investigation of complex problems, modern tools usage, ethics etc. that helps in outcome based assessment. 2. Members also observed that the assessment of higher order abilities and professional skills is in accordance with Bloom's taxonomy to a larger extent. Department does the assessment through fixed hour examinations as well as through course projects, mini / minor projects, internship experience and final year projects. 3. It is further observed that various innovative adaptive methods for teaching are being followed in the department like project based learning. It is recommended that department is open to adopt any new methods in future as suggested. 4. A comprehensive rubric is being followed to assess students for their project based learning during course project, minor/major project/internship. 5. The members also felt that further deliberations are required before adopting Open book examination. |
| 3. | Chemical Engineering | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Members welcomed these recommendations on mapping of course outcomes with performance indicators, course structure and assessments based on Bloom taxonomy and observed that most of these are being followed in the Department with regard to alignment of various graduate attributes like basic knowledge of engineering, science, applications, problems analysis, investigation of open ended and complex problems, thinking tools, ICT tools, ethics etc. that helps in outcome based assessment. 2. The Members also observed that the present assessment of understanding, analysis, thinking and creative abilities and professional competences of students done through fixed hour examination as well as through course projects, mini/minor projects internship experience and final year projects are in accordance with the Rubrics mentioned in the report. A comprehensive rubric is being followed to assess students for their project based learning during course project, minor/major project internship. 3. The Members also would be deliberating more upon the need to conduct Open book Examinations in various courses related to design of equipment, chemical processes, plants etc. |

The support systems like manpower, software, etc. should be enhanced before the implementation of examination reform in its proposed form.</p> <p>5. Since the entry and calculations are very large in number, it may not be possible by the course instructor. Hence TAs (M.Tech. & Ph.D. students) may be made accountable.</p> |
| 8. | Electronics and Communication Engineering | <p>1. Open Book examination should be optional. It may be conducted on the recommendation of concerned instructor and DUGC/DMPC.</p> <p>2. The academic 'Credit' points for Project works in B.Tech. final year should be increased to encourage project based learning. The number of theory courses in B.Tech. final year should be reduced.</p> <p>3. The quality of question papers should be monitored as per guidelines given in the documents.</p> <p>4. To teach and assess professional outcomes and cognitive abilities of the students, the use of MOOCs should be encouraged. However, the modalities must be decided based on the student strength and the infrastructure available.</p> |
| 9. | GIS Cell | Regarding implementation of examination reforms was discussed. Committee agrees for implementation of recommendations mentioned in this letter for the examination reforms. |
| 10. | Humanities and Social Sciences | All faculty members are in broad agreement with the recommendations and the same may be put up in the next Senate meeting for discussion and implementation. |
| 11. | Mathematics | Our department recommends that the present Examination System is good and needs no changes. However, if the Institute wants some change in the present examination system of the Institute, we do not have any objection. |
| 12. | Mechanical Engineering | <p>a) T. A. component should be made flexible from the presently used fixed 20% to a variable component of 20 to 50%.</p> <p>According to the examination component should also become flexible from 50% to 80% for all theory courses. The course coordinator should declare the distribution of TA and its components as well as the mid semester and semester examination at the beginning of the semester.</p> <p>b) Different components of TA should constitute quiz, assignments, course projects as well as oral presentation.</p> <p>c) The end semester examination marks for Practical Examination are currently 50%. This should be reduced to 30%. The TA component according should increase to 70%.</p> <p>3.
