**Item No. 73.04** : **To consider the progress of implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) – 2020 in the Institute.**

(a) **Discussion on two (02) new UG (B.Tech.) programmes proposed by Department of Applied Mechanics.**

(b) **Discussion on B.Tech. 1st Semester for Course Structure & Curriculum**

**Resolution** : a) The Senate considered the recommendation of the Sub-Committee constituted to consider the proposal of the Department of Applied Mechanics for starting two (02) new B.Tech. programmes in Engineering & Computational Mechanics; and Materials Engineering.

The Senate resolved to agree with the same in principle.

The Senate further resolved that a detailed proposal with requirements of faculty, staff and associated infrastructure may be placed before the Finance Committee and its Board of Governors for approval.

The Senate also resolved that on approval of the same by the Finance Committee / Board of Governors, the proposal will be submitted to the Ministry of Education for approval.

b) The Senate deliberated on the draft of B.Tech. 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Course Structure & Curriculum provided by different departments.

The Senate after detailed deliberations resolved to constitute a committee to prepare and recommend a common syllabus for B.Tech. first semester in-line with NEP 2020 as well as on the pattern of common syllabus for B.Tech. first semester of other premier higher educational institutions like IITs and IISc.





The recommendations of the Committee shall be placed before the Senate / Chairman, Senate for consideration.

**Item No. 73.05** : **To consider and finalize the norms for uploading the reports for B.Tech. project, M.Tech./ Ph.D. Thesis on [http://172.31.9.12/tab\\_fin](http://172.31.9.12/tab_fin) portal has already started from academic year 2020-21.**

**Resolution** : The Senate, considered the proposal on the norms (similarity check limit) for uploading the reports of B.Tech. project, M.Tech./ Ph.D. Thesis on [http://172.31.9.12/tab\\_fin](http://172.31.9.12/tab_fin) portal, and after detailed deliberations, resolved to approve the similarity check limit of 15% for uploading the reports of B.Tech. project, M.Tech./ Ph.D. Thesis on [http://172.31.9.12/tab\\_fin](http://172.31.9.12/tab_fin) portal from the academic session 2022-23.

**Item No. 73.06** : **To consider the observations of the Senate members on the draft Ordinances for Bachelors Programmes as recommended by the Ordinance Review Committee.**

**Resolution** : The Senate considered the observations of the Senate members on the draft Ordinances for Bachelors Programmes as recommended by the Ordinance Review Committee and after detailed deliberations observed that as per the resolution of the Senate on item 73.04 (b) a committee is to be constituted for finalizing the common course structure of B.Tech. first year for all branches.

The Senate in consideration of the above resolved to consider this agenda on receipt and acceptance of the recommendations of the Committee.

**Item No. 73.07** : **To consider nomination of one Senate nominee to the Board of Governors of the Institute, as a member of the Board of Governors.**

**Resolution** : The Senate considered the nomination of one Professor as a nominee of the Senate to the Board of Governors of the Institute as its member in terms of the Section 11 (f) of the NITSER Act-2007 as well as the guidelines accepted by the Senate for nomination of two members.



The Senate, in consideration of the above, resolved to nominate Prof. Ajai Kumar Singh, Department of Civil Engineering as a Professor nominee of the Senate to Board of Governors for period of two year w.e.f. April 01, 2022.

**Item No. 73.08** : To consider the resolution 60.07 (v) of 60<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Senate held on March 08, 2018 on the requirement of publication of papers for submission of thesis.

**Resolution** : The Senate considered the proposal and after deliberations resolved to accept for amendment as *"at least two accepted/published Journal papers in SSCI/SCI/Scopus indexed publications/ patent (approved / granted) as one of the criteria"* for submission of thesis. *The student shall be either the first author or second author (in case supervisor is the first author) and supervisor will certify that the papers are from the research work of the student."*

The Senate resolved that the amended norms shall be applied on the students who were admitted on or after session 2017-18.

**Item No. 73.09** : (a) To consider the request made by Mrs. Shashi Gupta, W/o Late Brig. Arvind Agrawal, who was an alumnus of the Institute of BE [Mechanical] first division with Honours in 1974 from MNNIT Allahabad, for Institution of a new sponsored gold medal in the memory of Late Brig. Arvind Agrawal.

(b) To consider the request made by Prof. Manoj Madhava Gore, S/o Late (Shrimati) Malati Madhava Gore, an alumnus of the Institute of M.Tech. [Computer Science and Engineering] First Batch [1989-91], for Institution of a new sponsored gold medal for Institute faculty member in the memory of Late (Shrimati) Malati Madhava Gore.



**Resolution** : (a) The Senate considered the request made by Mrs. Shashi Gupta, W/o Late Brig. Arvind Agrawal, an alumnus of BE (Mechanical) first division with Honours in 1974 of the Institute for institution of a new gold medal sponsored by her in the name of Late Brig. Arvind Agrawal to be named as "Late Brig. Arvind Agrawal Gold Medal", The medal will be awarded to the overall first position holder of Mechanical Engineering (first year) students of B.Tech. Programme and resolved to accept the same in principle.

(b) The Senate considered the request made by Prof. Manoj Madhava Gore, S/o Late (Shrimati) Malati Madhava Gore, an alumnus of the Institute of M.Tech. [Computer Science and Engineering] first batch [1989-91], for the institution of a new gold medal, sponsored by him in the name of Late (Shrimati) Malati Madhava Gore to be known as "Late (Shrimati) Malati Madhava Gore Memorial Gold Medal, for institute faculty member", which will be awarded to best faculty member among the Assistant Professors and Associate Professors of the institute working on permanent positions, and resolved to accept the same, in principle.

The Senate noted that as per guidelines approved by the Board of Governors for institution of a new sponsored gold medal, the proposal needs to be considered by a Committee, which has not been done in this case.

The Senate, considering the above resolved to route the same through the Committee and the recommendations of the Committee be put up before the Senate / Chairman, Senate.

**Item No. 73.10** : **To consider the proposal of the Professor In-charge (Training & Placement) for six (6) months internship for B.Tech Students of different departments.**

**Resolution** : The Senate considered the proposal of the Professor In-charge (Training & Placement) for six (6) months internship for B.Tech students of different departments and agreed to the same.





The Senate appreciated the six (6) months period internship proposals for B.Tech students, and advised to seek proposals from all the departments separately after deciding upon the adjustments of subjects to account for the credit requirements of the semester for which internship is permitted.

**Item No. 73.11** : **To consider the proposal for authorizing the Dean (Academic) as the signing authority for DP-15, DP-16 and DP-18 reports of Ph.D. Scholars, as an amendment of clause 12.3 of Doctoral Ordinances.**

**Resolution** : The Senate considered and approved the proposal for authorizing the Dean (Academic) as the signing authority for DP-15 and DP-16 of Ph.D. Scholars, thereby amending the Ordinance 12.4 of Doctoral Ordinances as follows:

***“12.4 Constitution of Thesis Evaluation Board***

*The Thesis Evaluation Board shall consist of two Examiners from outside the Institute, \_\_\_\_\_ of which at least one must be from India. The Thesis Supervisor(s) shall be member of \_\_\_\_\_ the evaluation Board. The Board shall be approved by the Dean (Academic).*

*1. The Thesis Supervisor(s) shall propose a list of Examiners consisting of seven experts including at least two from outside the country from Institutes of repute in prescribed format (Form: DP-15). A brief expertise of the proposed examiners may be attached with Form DP-15 for consideration of Chairperson SDPC and Dean (Academic). This list shall be forwarded by the Convener DDPC and HoD to Chairperson SDPC at the time of submission of the Thesis along with synopsis in soft copy prepared according to the prescribed guidelines GL-1. The Dean (Academic) in consultation with the Chairperson SDPC shall select the members of the Thesis Evaluation Board from this list. If considered necessary, the Dean (Academic) may ask for additional names of experts to be submitted or add additional names of experts in consultation with Chairperson SDPC.*

*2. In case Chairperson SDPC is the Supervisor of the student concerned, Dean (Academic) may consult Chairperson SMPC/SUGC to complete the process of approval of the Thesis Evaluation Board.*





3. If Dean (Academic) is the Thesis Supervisor then Chairperson SDPC shall approve the Thesis evaluation board in consultation with Chairperson SMPC.
4. If Dean (Academic) and Chairperson SDPC both are Supervisors, then Chairperson SMPC shall approve the Evaluation Board in consultation with Chairperson SUGC.
5. The names of the members of the Thesis Evaluation Board shall be kept confidential till successful completion of the Thesis Evaluation."

8. In addition to the above criteria, the candidate must satisfy the eligibility criteria given in the Ordinances for Doctoral programme.
9. The candidates under category 13 must fulfil the additional requirements of their sponsoring/funding agency, if any.
10. The concerned department shall ensure that the candidates meet the minimum eligibility criteria before taking the interview.
11. The concerned department shall also check all the documents / certificates / degree / caste certificate etc. of the candidates carefully during the interview, any mistake there after shall be the sole responsibility of the department.

#### Agenda Item

2. To decide on calling M.Tech./PhD 3<sup>rd</sup> semester onwards students in campus.

#### Resolution

1. In the light of the present COVID-19 situation, the committee decided to allow M.Tech./PhD 3<sup>rd</sup> semester onwards students to work from home with the guidelines laid down in notification no 484/Acad/2021-22 dt. Sept 30, 2021 .The committee further resolved the criteria /protocol, enclosed in annexure 1, for the students already residing the campus and willing to continue. They are also required to submit the undertakings mentioned in annexure III.

3. Conversion from full time to part time for M.Tech. students.

#### Resolution


The Committee considered the case of some M. Tech. candidates enrolled to the programme in the year 2020 or earlier, who have requested for conversion of their programme from full-time to part-time.

In the Ordinances for Masters Programme applicable to candidates admitted till the year 2020, there was no provision for such conversion. However, the Ordinances for Masters Programme applicable to candidates admitted from the year 2021 onwards, and currently in effect, allows conversion from full-time to part-time under clause 3.4.3, in case the student has registered in the IV Semester, and has got a job. Further, the National Education Policy of 2020 also envisages flexibility in the curriculum, along with multiple entry and exit options.

Keeping in mind the above, the Committee recommends that the benefit of conversion of M. Tech. students from full-time to part-time be extended to all those M.Tech. students who had enrolled prior to the Academic Session 2021-22 and hence after, provided that they should be able to

At the onset the Outgoing SUGC Chairman welcomed the new SUGC Chairman. Thereafter, the SUGC Chairman welcomed all the other members, including the new ones. No apologies from members were recorded.

The committee considered the following agenda items:

1. A) MED – via letter no. 5561/MED/F-34/2021 dated 05/10/2021 finally received on 21-10-2021 (Details enclosed vide SUGC Meeting dated 09/11/2021: Agenda No. 1 – Item No. 1)

- 1) Request of Mr. Ritik (Reg. No.20203121), a student of B.Tech. Mechanical Engineering to register afresh in the forthcoming first semester and leave for two semesters of the academic session 2020-21.

The student has applied for leave for 02 semesters of the academic session 2020-21 citing domestic and financial problems. The DUGC of MED had recommended for the award of 02 semesters leave.

However, on detailed examination of the student's application and records, the SUGC found that the student has not attended any classes nor has appeared at any of the examination of any subjects in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and thereby has a SPI of 0.0.

Further, he has also not registered for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and so far not even done the physical verification of admission documents. The student has since directly applied for leave after nearly an year of admission with no correspondence whatsoever, with any MNNIT faculty or official in between and also without enclosing any supporting documents substantiating his application.

**Decision:** The SUGC deliberated on the matter at length and agreed that the student application be sent back to MED for getting the supporting claim documents from the student, and send fresh firm recommendation, as per clauses 7

for Academic Performance Requirement and 8.3 of the UG Ordinance for Semester leave respectively, for any further processing or decision on his application.

- 2) Request of Ms. Anushka Ranjan (Reg. No.20193048), a student of B.Tech. Mechanical Engineering for grant of leave for one (2<sup>nd</sup>) semester.

The student is a 2019 registered student and had multiple course backlogs in 1<sup>st</sup> semester in the academic session 2019-20, which have since been cleared in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of next academic session i.e. 2020-21. Further, the student had already cleared all the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester courses in the academic session 2019-20 itself and thereby she had no courses to pursue in the even semester of the academic session 2020-21. Hence, the student has applied for leave for one semester i.e. for the even semester of academic session 2020-21. The DUGC of MED had recommended for the award of 01 semester leave.

**Decision:** The SUGC deliberated on the matter and agreed that the student be granted leave for the even semester of year 2020-21, as per clause 7 for Academic Performance Requirement of the UG Ordinance.

- B) MED – via letter no. 5661/MED/F-34/2021 dated 29/10/2021 and received on 08-11-2021

Vide DUGC MED meeting held online on 20/10/2021 in reference to the discussions of the Dean Academics with HODs and DUGC Convenors held on 11/10/2021 related to the course structure of 1st semester. (Details enclosed vide SUGC Meeting dated 09/11/2021: Agenda No. 1 – Item No. 2)

**Decision:** Given below as in the similar agenda item No. 2A.

- 2) CED – via letter no. 645/CED/2021-22 dated and received on 09-11-2021

- A) Vide CED department meeting held on 13/10/2021 in reference to the discussions of the Dean Academics with HODs and DUGC Convenors held on 11/10/2021 related to course structure of 1st semester. (Details enclosed vide SUGC Meeting dated 09/11/2021: Agenda No. 2 – Item No. 1)

**Decision:** The SUGC deliberated at length based on the above received minutes from MED and CED and the email reply of the Convenor DUGC, Chemistry department to the SUGC members. The SUGC unanimously suggested that the matter of proposed draft of the new curriculum / course structure (relevance, add, merge and drop of courses) for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester as per the NEP guidelines is a very important but sensitive one, with far reaching implications for MNNIT Allahabad.

*Further, it was also unanimously agreed that since branch sliding after 1<sup>st</sup> year is a major factor governing the adoption of a common course structure / curriculum in the 1<sup>st</sup> year, the said practice may be abolished, as is the case with majority of other NITs.*

Hence, the same be better deliberated again at an appropriate higher level at the Institute level (as the process is still ongoing), taking into account the needs of and inputs from the different stakeholder departments and the modern day engineering education requirements.

- B) CED – Mercy appeal of Mr. Aman Raj (Reg. No. 20201015) student of B.Tech. I semester CED to register in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester. (Details enclosed vide SUGC Meeting dated 09/11/2021: Agenda No. 2 – Item No. 2)

The student has got F grades in 12 courses in both B.Tech. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester and has a CPI of 1.44 at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> year. The student has reported to be suffering from depression and family pressures.

The DUGC CED recommended that the student may not be permitted to register in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester. However, the student has been recommended to register afresh in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester.


**Decision:** The SUGC deliberated on the matter and found that the student's claim of suffering from depression and family pressures is unsubstantiated, with no enclosed documentary evidence of medical problem or Corona related deaths in the family.

The SUGC recommends that the student would continue with his 2020 registration number i.e. 20201015 and may be allowed to register in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2021-22 session with the new batch of 1<sup>st</sup> year students, as per UG Ordinances.

Further, the SUGC observed that all the DUGC Convenors should **immediately deal with and regularly counsel such ACD cases** of their departments, likely leading to fewer complications in the future. In this respect kindly make a note of the Item no. 7 / pg 12 of the new UG Ordinances (given below)-


**\*\* The Dean (Academic) and the DUGC Convenors shall advise the students regarding remedial actions to be undertaken to remove the Academic Deficiencies.**

The committee considered the following agenda items from various.

1. CSED – via DUGC minutes dated 25/08/2021. Proposal from CSED regarding allowing Mr. Manish Praveen Barla, Reg No. 20154110, student of B.Tech. CSE programme who has completed upto 6<sup>th</sup> semester in the Old Curriculum to register in 7<sup>th</sup> semester and continue with the new curriculum.

**Decision:** The SUGC deliberated on the proposal and felt that since the total number of credits are not reduced and the student is not required to study any new courses, it can be considered and recommended for approval. Hence it is recommended that proposal by the department may be approved.

2. MED – via DUGC minutes dated 21/08/2021. Request by Mr. Shishir Acharya (Reg No. 20133018), B.Tech. Mechanical Engineering for extension of his B.Tech. programme and request for consideration of his supplementary examination in which he appeared in session 2020-21.

Mr. Shishir Acharya has to clear six courses till sixth semester. He appeared for supplementary for five subjects in 2020-21 session after registering for the same. However, since he did not have approval for extension of his programme beyond the maximum seven years (which finished in June 2020), his answer sheets were not evaluated. The department has recommended that the student may be given extension to his programme for the session 2020-21 due to the COVID situation and the session 2021-22 so that he may be able to complete the programme. Secondly the department also recommends approval for evaluation of examinations in which he appeared in 2020-21.

**Decision:** The SUGC recommends that Mr. Shishir Acharya may be given extension for 2020-21 and 2021-22 sessions as requested by the department and approval for evaluation of supplementary examinations in which he has appeared may also be granted.

3. MED - via DUGC minutes dated 01/09/2021. Request by Mr. Richard Eddy Mathew (Reg No. 20113080), B.Tech. Mechanical Engineering for extension of his B.Tech. programme for the session 2019-20

The student has cleared all subjects of his B.Tech. programme except Machine Design-I and Finite Elements Method in Engineering by appearing for supplementary exam in 2018-19 session for which he was granted extension. He could not request for extension of his programme for 2019-20 and 2020-21 due to financial and medical problems. The DUGC has recommended that his request to consider the supplementary exams which he appeared in 2021 may be granted so he would be able to complete his programme.


**Decision:** The SUGC recommends that Mr. Richard Eddy Mathew (Reg No. 20113080), B.Tech. may be granted extension of his B.Tech. programme for the session 2019-20 and 2020-21 and approval for evaluation of his supplementary examination in which he appeared in session 2020-21 may also be granted so as to enable him to complete his programme.

4. **Chemical Engg. Department – Request from Ms. Aradhana Kumari (reg No. 20149033), B.Tech. Chemical Engineering for extension of her programme to complete her degree and permission to register in seventh semester.** She has completed the maximum period of seven year in June 2021. She has to clear 11 subjects from the second to sixth semesters. The department has recommended extension of her programme by two years and permission to register in 5<sup>th</sup> Semester in the current semester and 6<sup>th</sup> semester in the next semester so as to enable her to clear her back papers.

**Decision:** The SUGC noted that the student needs an extension of her programme as she has finished the maximum of seven years as per the Ordinance. She is also not eligible to register in seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) semester as of now according to the Ordinance, even after extension of her programme, hence it is advised that she may register in 5<sup>th</sup> semester in the current odd semester and then clear the subjects in which she has E or F grades and similarly for the even semester (2021-22) and clear the subjects in which she has E or F grade. In light of the above the SUGC recommends that she be granted an extension of two years for the session 2021-22 and 2022-23 and permission to register for 5<sup>th</sup> semester and 6<sup>th</sup> semester in the odd and even semester of 2021-22.

5. **MED – via DUGC minutes dated 17/08/2021. Proposal from MED to run a new professional elective.**

The DUGC has proposed to run a new professional elective by name “Value Engineering” which is not included in the approved syllabus of B.Tech. in Mechanical Engineering or B.Tech. in Production and Industrial Engineering. The department has proposed the syllabus of the course as well as requested the Dean Academic office to assign a course code for the new course. The DUGC states that it was decided earlier that a more comprehensive list will be prepared for Mechanical Engineering as well as Production & Industrial Engineering students as professional electives in the coming months and will be sent for approval of the competent authorities. However, considering the response of the students for their choice of professional electives the DUGC forwards the proposal of the course







"Value Engineering" for the approval to be floated as professional elective for B.Tech. final year students of Production & Industrial Engineering and Mechanical Engineering in their seventh semester in the present session (2021-22).


**Decision:** It was noted by the members of SUGC that classes have started from 9<sup>th</sup> August 2021 by virtual mode and the request for approval of this course has come after starting the course and meanwhile the course has been running without approval of the competent authority. This is a serious procedural lapse on the part of the department as the course should have been approved before the start of the current semester. SUGC found the proposed course syllabus to be in order and as per usual convention the SUGC recommends approval for the course from next academic session. **However, the matter is forwarded for consideration by Chairman Senate from the current academic session if deemed fit as a special case in the interest of the students who are attending the classes for nearly four to five weeks now.**



Following were the resolutions of the meeting

- The Committee discussed the application of Mr. Sidharth (2019EM15). The concerned M.Tech. student Mr. Sidharth (2019EM15), was unable to complete his Thesis Work in his fourth Semester due to Covid infection of himself and his family members. Subsequently, after getting E Grade in his Final Thesis Examination in the 4th semester (held in July, 2021), he informed his supervisor that he has registered for the 5th Semester to continue on his thesis work. Accordingly, he continued with his thesis work in consultation with his supervisor at regular intervals during the Odd Semester 2021-22. After satisfactory completion of his work and submission of Thesis to his supervisor, his Final Thesis Examination was organized and conducted on December 08, 2021. However, at the end of the semester, when his marks / grades were to be entered, it was found on checking the registration documents from him that he had actually registered for the Supplementary Examination, instead of the 5th Semester. Due to this, his marks / grades could not be entered and his results were not declared. His current Academic Status is that of ACD, due to his E grade in his last (4th Sem) Thesis Examination, mentioned above.

In light of this, the SMPC committee has recommended to clear his ACD through the Supplementary Examination, which he has already registered. Further, since his examination has already been conducted, the same may be considered as his Supplementary Examination, to facilitate his results declaration at the earliest possible, in the interest of the career of the student.

2. The Committee discussed the request of Mr. Ajay Kumar Sahu (2020FE01). He did not report to the institute as per the notification of Dean (Academic) and was allowed for work from home as he had not taken even a single dose of vaccine till date. Further, the student took the first dose of vaccine and informed to report in the last week of December 2021 after taking second dose of vaccination. The student did not appear in the special study examination (4 credits) and was awarded "F" grade by the committee. His thesis examination was scheduled on December 19 and 20, 2021, the student sent an email to the Head, AMD and requested for semester leave "some health issues as well as domestic problems and because of which he couldn't work on the special study as well on thesis work". His application for semester leave was recommended and forwarded by his supervisor.

The SMPC committee discussed the case and after deliberations decided to recommend for semester leave (3rd Semester, Odd 2021-22) and register again in the 3rd semester in the Even semester (2021-22).

3. The committee discussed the request of Mr. Piyush Pal Singh (Reg No 2019 CS18) regarding conversion of his M.Tech. programme from full time to part time. Mr. Piyush Pal Singh (2019CS18) is currently working in the Central for Railway Information Systems (CRIS) as Assistant Software Engineer since January 2021. He has completed three semesters of M.Tech. successfully. Earlier, on the recommendation of DMPC and SMPC, he was given semester leave for even semester 2020-21 and odd semester 2021-22. Now, he is requesting for continuing his M.Tech. programme along with the CRIS job.

The committee discussed the case and recommended to convert his M.Tech. full time to part time as per the approval of minutes of Standing Committee Meeting held on January 03, 2022.

4. Mr. Himanshu Gautam (2021IS42) was registered in first semester of M.Tech. Information Security. The student did not attend any class of first semester, the DMPC committee advised him to take semester leave for odd semester (2021-22). The odd semester leave was approved by the competent authority. The student is again applying for the semester leave of even semester (2021-22). In the light of above observations,

The SMPC committee has recommended semester leave for current semester (even semester 2021-22) as per the ordinances of Masters Programme 5.2.

5. The committee discussed the request of Mr. Mudit Gupta (2020PR11) a student of M.Tech. Production Engineering (ME) for conversion of M.Tech. programme from full time to part time, as he has joined SBI under compassionate appointment scheme.. Mr. Mudit Gupta, lost his father due to COVID-19 who was the employee of State Bank of India. In accordance to the compassionate appointment scheme of State Bank of India, SBI offered him a post to take care of his family to which he accepted the offer.

The student himself admitted that he could not make any progress in his thesis in an email dated Nov 19, 2021 and said that he was having backlogs in B.Tech. This issue was reported to Dean (Academic) and subsequently he was terminated from M.Tech. Programme on Dec 6, 2021. In the meantime, student appeared in special study (and obtained Grade C) but could not appear in thesis semester progress presentation due to termination. After that, the student submitted application to the Dean (Academic) along with provisional documents (his termination was withdrawn thereafter) and was permitted to register by Dean (Academics) in the even

semester (2021-22) on 10-01-2022. As per clause 9.1 (1) of the Ordinance of Masters Programme, the student was terminated by Head of the department. Now the student has submitted a mercy application to the department on 31-01-2022 to withdraw his termination and allow him to give thesis examination for third semester.

**The committee discussed the case sympathetically and recommended for the restoration of his M.Tech. programme and the student may be allowed for semester leave in the odd semester (2021-22) and he may again register in the third semester of even semester academic session 2021-22.**
