The Director extended a warm welcome to the new member of Board of Governors, Prof. Shubhi Purwar, Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering, MNNIT Allahabad, who was attending the meeting for the first time.

The Board of Governors noted that the term of Prof. Ajai Kumar Singh as Member of the Board of Governors ended on 31.03.2024 and further acknowledged and appreciated the contributions made by Prof. Ajai Kumar Singh as Member of the Board of Governors, MNNIT Allahabad.

The Board of Governors took on record the comments received from the IFD, MoE vide letter No. F. No. 3-18/2013-IFD dated 21.06.2024 on the agenda items of the Seventieth [70th] meeting of the Finance

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Committee and Seventy-fifth [75th] meeting of the Board of Governors of MNNIT Allahabad. The Comments received from IFD, MoE is at ANNEXURE-I

The Board of Governors deliberated on the agenda items, and agenda item-wise proceedings are as under:

Item No. 75.01 :

To confirm the minutes of the Seventy-fourth [74th] meeting of the Board of Governors held on 05.12.2023.

The Board of Governors, considering the above, resolved to confirm the minutes of its Seventy-fourth [74th] meeting held on 05.12.2024.

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Item No. 75.03 :

Resolution

The Director presented the report, and apprised the Board of Governors about the activities & developments in the Institute, since the last meeting of the Board of Governors.

The Board of Governors expressed pleasure over the progress made by the Institute during the period.

The Board of Governors noted that the term of appointment of Prof. Ajai Kumar Singh, Professor, Department of Civil Engineering and as member of the Board of Governors in the capacity of nominee of Senate has been completed on 31.03,2024.

The Board acknowledged the contributions made by Prof. Ajai Kumar Singh during his term as a member of the Board of Governors of the Institute.

The Board of Governors also noted that the Senate in its Seventy-ninth [79th] meeting held on 23.04.2024 vide resolution No. 79.14 has nominated Prof. Shubhi Purwar, Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering as a nominee of the Senate to the Board of Governors for a period of two years effective from 23.04.2024.

The Board noted the above nomination of Prof. Shubhi Purwar.

The Board of Governors noted that the term of Prof. Ajai Kumar Singh as member of the Finance Committee ended on 31.03.2024.

The Board of Governors resolved to nominate Prof. Shubhi Purwar, Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering as nominee of the Board of Governors from amongst its members to the Finance Committee of the Institute, as per Statute 10 (1) (iv) of the First Statutes of all NITs., w.e.f. 21.06.2024.

- 2. As per the new National Education policy (NEP-2020) of the Government of India such programmes are required and will contribute towards fulfilling the manpower requirement of the Government of India.
- The Ministry of Education letter D.O.F.No.33-3/2018-TS.III, dated 27.12.2019 provides that in order to rein the over expenditure owing to starting of new programmes by NITs without approval of Ministry of Education, the institutions need to seek prior approval of the Ministry of Education, before making any budgetary provisions for the same. The Ministry of Education has also directed that in order to seek prior approval of the Ministry, Institutions need to submit the detailed proposal, after the approval of the Finance Committee/ Board of Governors.

Considering above, the Board of Governors resolved to accept the proposal for starting new Master of Social Work (MSW) Programme in Department of Humanities & Social Sciences as per the recommendations of the Senate for further submission to the Ministry of Education for approval.

Item No. 75.06 : To consider the proposal of In-principal approval for opening a U.G. Programme based on NEP-2020 in Aerospace Engineering i.e. B. Tech. in Aerospace Engineering.

The Board considering the Institute proposal resolved to give In-principal approval for opening a U.G. Programme based on NEP-2020 in Aerospace Engineering i.e. B. Tech. in Aerospace Engineering. The Board of Governors authorized director to constitute a committee incorporating experts from IITs/NITs/CFTIs etc. to decide the detailed modalities for running such programmes smoothly. As per Ministry of

Education letter D.O.F.No.33-3/2018-TS.III, dated 27.12.2019, the proposal may further be submitted to the Ministry of Education for approval.

Item No. 75.07 : To consider the proposal of In-principal approval for opening a new campus of MNNIT Allahabad outside the country.

The Board of Governors observed the following:



- (ii) Further, on receipt of any such proposal from foreign country the same shall be presented before the Board of Governors for consideration, along with the comments/observations from the Ministry of External Affairs and Ministry of Education.


Item No. 75.09 : To consider the Ministry of Education email dated 27.03.2024 thereby enclosing Letter F. No. 35-2/2024-TS.III dated 27.03.2024 on the subject "Observations of the President's Secretariat to make suitable amendment in the Statute to prevent overlap between responsibilities of Director and Chairperson, Board of Governors (BoGs)- regarding",

Resolution

The Board of Governors considered the Ministry of Education email dated 27.03.2024 thereby enclosing Letter F. No. 35-2/2024-TS.III dated 27.03.2024 on the subject "Observations of the President's Secretariat to make suitable amendment in the Statute to prevent overlap between responsibilities of Director and Chairperson, Board of Governors (BoGs)- regarding."

The Board was apprised the with following:

Ministry of Education through its letter dated 27.03.2024 has instructed to amend the existing clause 17(15) of the Statutes of NITs, to prevent existing overlap between the responsibilities of the Director and Chairperson of Board of Governors, and to include a clause with respect to extending the tenure of the Chairperson, Board of Governors.




2. At present, there are no provisions under the Statutes to extend the term of incumbent Chairperson, BoGs or assign the temporary or additional charge of the post of Chairperson, BoGs to the Chairperson, BoGs of any other NITs or CFTIs in the event of occurrence of any vacancy in the office of Chairperson for any reason. As per the instructions received from the President's Secretariat, Institute is required to initiate amendment to insert following clause (v) in Statute 14 of Statutes of NITs and IIEST, Shibpur:

"In the event of the occurrence of any vacancy in the office of the Chairperson of Board of Governors by reason of expiry of his or her tenure, death, resignation or otherwise or in the event of the Chairperson being unable to discharge his or her functions owing to absence, illness or any other cause, the Chairperson of an Institute of National Importance (INI) nominated by the Visitor to fill up the casual vacancy, may discharge the functions assigned to the Chairperson under Section 16 of the Act, for a period of six months or till the nomination of a regular Chairperson, whichever is earlier.

Additionally, in case of expiry of tenure, the Visitor may extend the term of the incumbent Chairperson for a period of six months or till the nomination of a regular Chairperson, whichever is earlier."

3. As the relevant provisions in the Statutes are being inserted under clause (v) of Statute 14 of the Statutes in order to have clear distinctions between the responsibilities of Director and Chairperson and to prevent any overlap of functions provided in the Statutes, it is, therefore, necessary to delete clause (15) of Statute 17 of the Statutes of NITs and IIEST-Shibpur, which exist as under:-

"In the event of the occurrence of any vacancy in the office of the Chairperson by reason of his death, resignation, or otherwise or in the event of the Chairperson being unable to discharge his functions owing to absence, illness or any other cause, the Director may discharge the functions assigned to the Chairperson under Section 16 of the Act".



Considering the above details, the Board of Governors resolved to accept the following amendments in the Statutes:

- [I] To insert the clause (v) in Statute 14 of Statutes of NITs and IIEST, Shibpur, as mentioned in the point No. 02 above.
- [II] To delete clause (15) of Statute 17 of the Statutes of NITs and IIEST-Shibpur, as mentioned in the point No. 03 above.

Further, the Board of Governors directed the Institute to forward the above recommendation of the Board to the Ministry of Education for placing the same before the Hon'ble Visitor of NITs & IIEST, Shibpur for consideration and approval in terms of provisions under Section 26 (3) & (4) of the NITSER Act, 2007.

Item No. 75.10 : To consider the following Recruitment Matters

- [A] To consider the confirmation of the faculty member appointed on regular basis and have completed the prescribed period of probation of one year.

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

The Board of Governors considered the ACoFAR recommendations for merging the cadre positions at the Assistant Professor (Grade-II, Level 11) & Assistant Professor (Grade-II, Level 10). The Board deliberated on the issue thoroughly and opined that only merging of Level-10 and Level-11 of a cadre 'Assistant Professor Grade-II' will not solve the problem of the Institute significantly and is also not in accordance with the Central Education Institutions (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act, 2019/DoPT guidelines of faculty recruitment. The Board noted the issue of fewer vacancies at the higher cadres, i.e. at Professor and Associate Professor Levels.

The Board of Governors noted that as per Ministry of Education letter F.No. 33-3/2018-TS.III dated 5.11.2019 regarding Implementation of Central Education Institutions (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act, 2019 in NITs and IIEST, Shibpur, Institutes are required to maintain their rosters according to the strength of the teachers' cadre.

In view of the above, and as per prevailing Four-tier Flexible Faculty Cadre Structure, the Board directed the Institute that at the beginning of every Financial Year, the Institute/ACoFAR will report the vacancies at the faculty level to the Board and the Board will decide the distribution of vacant faculty positions among Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor as per Flexible Faculty Cadre Structure in NITs as specified in Ministry of Education letter F.No. 35-3/2021—TS.III dated 23.03.2022. Accordingly, the Institute will prepare the Reservation Roster Register and get it approved by the Board.


In view of above, and as this is the First meeting in the Financial Year 2024-25, therefore the Board of Governors considered the following for the FY 2024-25:

(i) The Board of Governors noted that at present there are 115 vacancies across all levels in in the faculty positions. For the current FY – 2024-25, the vacant faculty positions is to be distributed among Professor, Associate Professor & Assistant Professor in the ratio of 1:2:4. Further, the Assistant Professor [Level 10, 11 & 12] vacant positions may also be distributed among Assistant Professor [Level 10], Assistant Professor [Level 11] & Assistant Professor [Level 12] in the ratio of 1:2:4. Accordingly, the vacancies at the various levels of faculty positions are as under:

In view of above, Board of Governors directed the Institute to conduct the faculty recruitment for the FY 2024-25 as per above details following the overall Four-tier Flexible Faculty Structure communicated vide Ministry of Education letter F.No. 35-3/2021-TS.III dated 23.03.2022.

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[D] The Board of Governors considered the matter of method of Recruitment clause in the Recruitment Rules (2019) for the post of Registrar.

The Board was apprised with the following details in the matter:

- (i) Institute has advertised the positions of Registrar in the Institute vide advertisement No. 07/2023 dated 17.10.2023, according to the provisions of Recruitment Rules (2019) for the post of Registrar in NITs communicated by Ministry of Education vide letter No. F.35-5/2018-TS.III dated 04.04.2019.
- (ii) In response, very few candidates applied, also, among those who have applied most of them are not eligible because of the following clause(s) of the Recruitment Rules (2019) that has been changed in comparison to the previous Recruitment Rules for the post of Registrar [Communicated vide Ministry of Education letter No. F.33- 2/2012-TS.III dated 05.02.2014]:



(III) The Institute vide letter No. 629/Reg. Off./2023-24 dated 29.12.2023 and again vide letter No. 658/Reg. Off./2023-24 dated 24.01.2024 requested the Ministry of Education to kindly examine the above changes in the Recruitment Rules (2019) for the position of Registrar and give suitable directions in the matter. However, the response from the Ministry of Education is awaited.

In consideration of the above, the representatives from the Ministry apprised the following to the Board during the meeting:

It was also apprised to the Board by the representatives from Ministry that the other NITs have also done the Registrar recruitment by amending the above clause.

In view of above, the Board of Governors resolved to recommend that the post of Registrar may be re-advertised with the above amendment at the SI. No. 11 Experience column of the Recruitment Rules 2019 for the post of Registrar in NITs.


[E] The Board of Governors was apprised with the current status of ongoing faculty recruitment process. The Board was informed that as per the Ministry of Education Letter No. F. No. 9-1/2021-TS.III dated 31.08.2021, the Ministry has directed that the backlog vacancies in respect of SC/ST, OBC and EWS may be filled up immediately and other vacancies may be filled up once consolidated guidelines, as per the CEI Act, 2019, are issued by the Ministry.

The Board noted that the Institute has advertised all the vacant faculty positions at the level of Assistant Professor [Academic Level 10 /11/12] Associate Professor and Professor [Academic Level :13 & 14A] for different departments of the Institute vide rolling advertisement No. 05/2023, dated 06.07.2023. This rolling advertisement will be an ongoing recruitment process for all positions.

The Board advised the Institute to make all possible efforts to fill the vacant faculty positions and minimize the vacancies, on priority.

Item No. 75.11 : To consider the following Administrative Matters

- [A] To consider the Institute proposal of renaming of Fee Head "Alumni Fee" to "Endowment Fund".
- [B] To consider the re-allocation of space allocated for TBI project at single location only adjacent to existing location instead of at two different locations at present.



Resolution

: [A]

The Board of Governors considered the Institute proposal of renaming of Fee Head "Alumni Fee" to "Endowment Fund" in detail.

The Board was apprised that the Alumni Fee of ₹2000/- is taken from the students while they are studying their UG/PG/Ph.D programme whereas, they become Alumni after getting degree in the Convocation after completion of the Programme.

The Board of Governors made the following observations:

- (i) Alumni fee should be voluntary.
- (ii) Institute should not be a part of the management of such funds and MNNIT Alumni Association may encourage the passout students/alumni to raise/donate the funds voluntarily for the welfare of all the stake holders of the Institute/Association.

In view of above, the Board of Governors has not acceded to the Institute proposal of renaming Fee Head and advised the Institute that the alumni fee should not be charged by the Institute and the same may be managed by the MNNIT Alumni Association from the passing out students/Alumni. The Board also directed the Institute that the existing funds in the "Alumni Fee" Head may be transferred to the MNNIT Alumni Association.

[B] The Board of Governors considered the matter of Re-allocation of space (10,000 sq. ft.) for establishment of an 'Inclusive Technology Business Incubator (i-TBI)' in healthcare and IoMT with NIDHI i-TBI, DST at MNNIT Allahabad.

 - Also, it is proposed that the fee structure may be reviewed in every three years to keep pace with changing socio-economic dynamics.
- (iv) Further, the Ministry of Education vide letter F. No. 33-4/2014-TS.III, dated 02.07.2016 on the subject "Revision of fees in the NITs and IIEST issue of clarification" at point No. (ii) has clarified the following:
 - "(ii) Tuition fee to be charged for MBA and five years M.Sc. programmes

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may be decided by the concerned NIT because of variation in entry behaviour."

Considering above, the Finance Committee resolved to accept the Institute proposal for enhancement in tuition fee for MBA program from ₹12000 to ₹48000 from next academic session and the fee structure shall be reviewed in every three years to keep pace with changing socio-economic dynamics.
