Item No. 70.04 : To consider the Institute proposal for enhancement in tuition fee for MBA program from next academic session.

Resolution

The Finance Committee noted the following:

- (i) The existing tuition fee of the Management Programme [MBA Programme] is stagnant for many years and below par with other NITs/IITs.
- (ii) The present fee of other NITs/IITs/IIITs are in the ranges from ₹35000 to ₹100000.
- (iii) The Departmental Committee of the School of Management Studies has proposed to enhance the tuition fee of MBA programme from ₹12000 to ₹48000 from next academic session to make it at par with other NITs/IITs/IIITs.
 - Also, it is proposed that the fee structure may be reviewed in every three years to keep pace with changing socio-economic dynamics.
- (iv) Further, the Ministry of Education vide letter F. No. 33-4/2014-TS.III, dated 02.07.2016 on the subject "Revision of fees in the NITs and IIEST issue of clarification" at point No. (ii) has clarified the following:
 - "(ii) Tuition fee to be charged for MBA and five years M.Sc. programmes

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may be decided by the concerned NIT because of variation in entry behaviour."

Considering above, the Finance Committee resolved to accept the Institute proposal for enhancement in tuition fee for MBA program from ₹12000 to ₹48000 from next academic session and the fee structure shall be reviewed in every three years to keep pace with changing socio-economic dynamics. The Finance Committee recommended the Institute proposal to the Board of Governors for approval and implementation in the Institute.

Item No. 70.05 : To consider the recommendation of the Seventy-ninth [79th] meeting of the Senate held on 23.04.2024 on the following agenda items:

recommendation of the Seventy-ninth [79th] meeting of the Senate held on 24.03.2024 on the report submitted by the Committee constituted vide the resolution No. 78.05 for framing the guidelines for financial assistance to students for attending Conferences and recommended the same to Board of Governors for approval.

[B] The Finance Committee considered the recommendation of the Seventy-ninth [79th] meeting of the Senate held on 23.04.2024 vide resolution No. 79.11 for fixing an honorarium of Rs. 3000 to the external examiner, apart from the actual travelling expenses and daily allowance as per Gol rules for external evaluation of M.Tech. Thesis in IV Semester of M.Tech. Programme and other PG Programmes.

In consideration of the Institute proposal the Finance Committee advised the following:

- (i) M.Tech. is a time bound programme therefore, the report of the external expert should also be time bound to avoid delay in declaration of the result and other unnecessary issues.
- (ii) Institute should ensure to develop a mechanism such that the degree of the M.Tech. candidates may not be stopped in lieu of the external report of the external examiner. Therefore, the Finance Committee advised the Institute that the external examiner should not be made mandatory and may be exercised as an optional provisions only.

In consideration of above, the Finance Committee resolved to accept the recommendation of the Seventy-ninth [79th] meeting of the Senate held on 24.03.2024 vide resolution No. 79.11 for fixing an honorarium of Rs. 3000 to the external examiner, apart from the actual travelling expenses and daily allowance as per Gol rules for external evaluation of M.Tech. Thesis in IV Semester of M.Tech. Programme and other PG Programmes and recommended the same to the Board of Governors for approval.
