The new Chairperson, SDPC Prof. Basant Kumar was welcomed by Chairperson, Senate and Outgoing Chairperson Prof. Vijaya Bhadauria was thanked for the services rendered as the Chairperson, SDPC.

A copy of the approved minutes of SDPC is placed at **ANNEXURE-V**. While reporting the duly approved minutes of the SDPC, the Chairman SDPC referred the following resolutions of SDPC meeting held on April 09, 2024 which were referred to the Senate for further deliberations:

- i. The Senate considered the matter of continuing the supervision/co-supervision of Ph.D students of newly joined faculty from their previous organisations. The Senate deliberated on this matter and resolved that the faculty may continue supervising the students from their previous organisation subject to a limit of maximum 2 students. This supervision will be over and above the present entitlement of faculty in terms of numbers of Ph.D. supervision.
- ii. The Senate considered the request of Ms. Rachna Jain (Currently working as project staff [JRF] in the GIS Cell) for relaxing/waiving off the Institute requirement of GATE/NET and considering her candidature for Ph.D programme in category 14 and resolved to constitute a committee of All HoDs and Dean (Academic) under the Chairmanship of Dean (R&C) for submission of final recommendation to Chairman, Senate for approval on this matter.
- iii. The Senate also deliberated and discussed on the recommendations of SDPC for abolishing clause 12.6 [2(c)] of the current ordinances for the Doctoral programme which is stated below:

"The Research Scholar shall submit Rs. 10,000/- per semester in institute as supervision fee in lieu of facilitating the Institute faculty as his/her Supervisor / Co- Supervisor. This fee will include fee for utilization of research facilities such

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as labs, library, Software's etc. to the Research Scholars on Saturday only."

The Senate resolved that the requirement of submission of Rs. 10,000 per semester may be waived off subject to the approval of the Finance Committee. However, the research scholar will have to bear all expenses related to use of Institute lab / computational facilities.

Item No. 79.05

To consider the revised format of Degree Certificate with Digital Signature.

Resolution

: The Senate considered the revised format of Degree Certificate with Digital Signature and resolved to accept the revised format of Degree Certificate with Digital Signature after approval from the Board of Governors.

The Senate further advised the Dean (Academic) to prepare detailed operational modalities for preparing the Degree Certificate with Digital Signatures with Signatures of Chairperson, Board of Governors and the Chairman, Senate on the front and the Digital signature of Registrar on the back of the Certificate. Secretary, Senate/ Registrar will be the custodian of all records related to degree certificate and the counter signature of the Registrar will enable authentication as well as verification with improved security and accountability.

The process of obtaining the Digital Signature Certificate from the Chairperson, Board of Governors and the Chairman, Senate will be co-ordinated by the Office of the Secretary, Senate/ Registrar.

To consider the Academic Calendar for Academic Session 2024-25.

Resolution

The Senate considered the Academic Calendar for Academic Session 2024-25 and advised that the activities may be rescheduled so that End Semester Examination of Even Semester of Academic Session 2024-25 may be completed by 20.05.2025 (Tentatively).

Further, the Senate resolved to prepone the Summer Vacation for session 2023-24 from June 01, 2024 to July 21, 2024 in light of rescheduling the exam of 2023-24 duly approved by Chairperson, Senate. The Senate also resolved that the revised schedule may be submitted to the Chairman, Senate for final approval and

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associated implementation.

Item No. 79.07

To consider the discontinuation of Branch Sliding procedure in B.Tech. Programme.

Resolution

The Senate considered discontinuation of Branch Sliding procedure in B.Tech. Programme and observed that presently the branch sliding rules for Undergraduate students are governed by clause 5.4 of the Ordinances for Bachelors' programme where Students whose branches are changed because of branch sliding are required to earn additional credits viz. credits over and above the total credit requirement of the associated branch-specific programme for the left out courses, which the student will study to meet the academic requirements for completing the programme. The credits earned in the B. Tech. I and II Semesters in the branch specific courses of previous branch viz. branch allotted in I year, are not accounted for meeting the credit requirement of the branch, after sliding.

Due to branch specific courses from the first Semester itself under NEP-2020, such courses are necessary for academic completeness of the programme for all such students. This leads to additional academic load on the students.

In light of the above, the Senate resolved to discontinue the Branch Sliding procedure in B.Tech. Programme from Academic Session 2024-25 in order to reduce stress amongst the students.

Item No. 79.08

To consider the report submitted by the Committee constituted vide the resolution No. 78.04 (i) for adopting one standard style of nomenclature for offering minor(s).

Resolution

The Senate considered the recommendation of the committee of all HoDs and Dean (Academic) with Prof. Mukul Shukla, Head MED as Chairman and Assistant Registrar (Academic) as Convenor, duly approved by the Chairman, Senate on the matter and resolved to adopt one standard style of nomenclature for offering minor(s) as proposed by the committee with minor changes.

Item No. 79.09

: To consider the report submitted by the Committee constituted vide the resolution No. 78.05 for framing the guidelines for financial assistance to students for attending Conferences.

Resolution

- The Senate considered the recommendation of the committee of all HoDs and Dean (Academic) with Prof. Mukul Shukla, Head MED as Chairman and A.R. (Academic) as Convenor duly approved by the Chairman, Senate for framing the guidelines for financial assistance to students for attending Conferences and resolved that:
  - 1. The maximum support which may be availed by a a UG, PG student and Ph.D research scholar within the entire course duration is Rs. 80,000 for a single conference outside India.
- 2. The maximum support which may be availed by a UG, PG student and Ph.D research scholar within the entire course duration will be Rs. 20,000 for a single conference within India on reimbursement basis.
- 3. DA shall be admissible for actual days of the conference + 2 days. (Amount of DA will be equal to half the amount admissible to an Assistant Professor, as per institute rules).
- 4. Maximum AC-2 tier rail fare and economy class air tickets (booked from authorized agents as per institute rules) shall be allowed.
- 5. The National/International Conference should be non-predatory, peer reviewed and indexed, with evidence of online publication of proceedings/article(s).
- 6. This financial assistance is not allowed for online participation.

The Senate also resolved that the above shall be subject to the approval of Finance Committee and the order for financial support shall be issued as per the

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fund availability in respective head.

To consider the report submitted by the Committee constituted vide the resolution No. 78.08 for Institutional membership of MNNIT for The Institutions of Engineers (India).

Resolution

: The Senate considered the recommendation of the committee of all HoDs and Dean (Academic) with Prof. Mukul Shukla, Head MED as Chairman and A.R. (Academic) as Convenor, duly approved by the Chairman, Senate for Institutional membership of MNNIT for The Institutions of Engineers (India) and resolved **not** to avail the Institutional membership of MNNIT for The Institutions of Engineers (India).

To consider the report submitted by the Committee constituted vide the resolution No. 78.09 to prepare the SOPs for external evaluation of M.Tech. Thesis in IV Semester of M.Tech. Programme and other PG Programmes.

Resolution

The Senate considered the recommendation of the committee of all HoDs and Dean (Academic) with Prof. Mukul Shukla, Head MED as Chairman and A.R. (Academic) as Convenor, duly approved by the Chairman, Senate to prepare the SOPs for external evaluation of M.Tech. Thesis in IV Semester of M.Tech. Programme and other PG Programmes and resolved to recommend that the departments may opt for appointment of an external examiner, as per the provision of the ordinances, for increased interaction with national level academic institutes and research organizations/laboratories. The external examiner should be from institutes of repute including top 100 N.I.R.F. ranked Institutes/ CFTIs/ Central Universities/ Research labs etc. The Senate also resolved to fix an honorarium of Rs. 3000 to the external examiner, apart from the actual travelling expenses and daily allowance as per Gol rules.

Further, the Senate also resolved that the allotment of the PG Thesis Supervisor may preferably be done in the First Semester for M.Tech., or latest within 2 months of the Second Semester.

To consider the report submitted by the Committee constituted vide the resolution No. 78.11 for considering the proposal of starting PDF fellowship at the Institute as proposed by the Dean (R &C).

Resolution

The Senate considered the recommendation of the committee of all HoDs and Dean (Academic) with Prof. Mukul Shukla, Head MED as Chairman and A.R. (Academic) as Convenor, duly approved by the Chairman, Senate for considering the proposal of starting PDF fellowship at the Institute as proposed by the Dean (R &C) and resolved to defer the matter for the next Senate meeting, for gathering more information regarding eligibility, fellowship and associated fund allocation etc. as proposed by the committee.

For Third Semester the present clause as per the Ordinance will hold.



(2) SDPC discussed the recommendation of the DDPC of Department of Civil Engineering on the case of Mr. Arjit Verma (2016RCE04), who acquired 4X's in the odd semester 2023-24, From the results of all the semesters of the student, it was confirmed that the student acquired 9Xs at the end of odd semester 2023-24.

The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend termination as per the Clause No. 8.1(1.e) of the "Ordinance of Doctoral Programme" because the student acquired more than 8X in all, during his Ph.D programme.

(3) SDPC discussed the recommendation of the DDPC of Department of Civil Engineering on the case of Ms. Manjul Sharma (2020RCE08) regarding 'Semester Leave', It was also mentioned that student had already taken 'Semester Leave' in the previous semester (Odd Semester, 2023-24).

The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend 'Semester Leave' for the current semester (Even Semester 2023-24) as per the Clause Nos. 5.2 of the "Ordinance of Doctoral Programme" on sympathetic ground.

(4) SDPC discussed the recommendation of the DDPC of Computer Science Engineering Department on the case of Mr. Kashif Mazhar (2021RCS12) regarding 'Semester Leave' for Even Semester of 2023-24, on medical grounds.

The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend 'Semester Leave' for Even Semester (Session 2023-24) to Mr. Kashif Mazhar (2021RCS12) as per the Clause Nos. 5.2 of the "Ordinance of Doctoral Programme"

(5) SDPC discussed the recommendation of the DDPC of Department of Electronics Engineering on the case of Dr. Vimal Kumar Singh Yadav, Assistant Professor, ECED for his request to continue acting as Co-supervisor of Two Ph.D students (Ms. Nikhat Anjum and Mr. Mahendra Das of BIT Mesra, Ranchi, Jharkhand, whom he has been supervising since 2022 during his tenure as faculty of BIT Mesra, before joining MNNIT Allahabad.

The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend Dr. Vimal Kumar Singh Yadav, Assistant Professor, ECED, to continue as co-supervisor of two Ph.D students (Ms. Nikhat Anjum and Mr. Mahendra Das of BIT Mesra, Ranchi, Jharkhand.

(6) SDPC discussed the recommendation of the DDPC of Department of Biotechnology on the case Dr. Monica Prakash Rai, Associate Professor in the Department of Biotechnology, for her request to continue acting as Co-supervisor of Ph.D student Ms. Reetu of Amity University, Noida, whom she has been supervising during the tenure as faculty of Amity University, before joining MNNIT Allahabad.

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The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend Dr. Monica Prakash Rai to act as co-supervisor of Ph.D student (Ms. Reetu)

(7) SDPC discussed the recommendation of the DDPC of Department of Electrical Engineering on year. The candidate delivered the state-of-the-art presentation in the odd semester 2019-20. It was also mentioned in the application that he communicated two papers in SCI journals, and the other two papers in SCI journals, and the

The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend an extension of one year in the Ph.D programme to Mr. Chandra Sekar S. (2018REE09) for the session 2024-25.

(8) The SDPC discussed the case of Mr. Aditya Agnihotri (2022REE02) of Department of Electrical Engineering and took note of his absence from the department since 28/07/2023.

In the light of this, SDPC recommends that department should initiate action against the student, as per the provision laid down in clause 5.5 of "Ordinance of Doctoral Programme" for the "long absence without leave"

(9) The SDPC discussed the recommendation of DDPC of HSS Department on the case of Ms. Navneeta Shome (2021RHU51), She was registered till the EVEN Semester of 2022-23 (Semester III), but failed to appear for her Comprehensive Examination and deliver her State-ofthe-Art Seminar. She also did not get herself registered in the Subsequent Semesters.

The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend termination as per clause 4.5 of the Doctoral Ordinance.

(10) The SDPC discussed the recommendation of DDPC of GIS Cell on the case of Ms. Rachna Jain (Currently working as project staff [JRF] in the cell), for relaxing /waiving off the institute requirement of GATE/NET and considering her candidature for Ph.D programme in category 14.

SDPC discussed the matter and deliberated in detail on the cases of discontinuance of project staff in the middle of the ongoing research projects. In light of this, SDPC felt the need for encouraging project staffs to apply for Ph.D programme. Therefore, SDPC strongly recommends the relaxation/waive-off the requirement of GATE/NET for admission in Ph.D programme under category 14, for applicants who are working as project staff in the institute.

(11) SDPC took note of the Clause 12.6 of the current Ordinance for Doctoral Programme, which states about the "Guidelines for Institute Faculty for supervising/ Co-Supervising students of Other Institute/ University. After discussion, SDPC unanimously felt the need for abolishing clause 12.6[2(c)] which is stated as:-

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"The Research Scholar shall submit Rs. 10,000/- per semester in institute as supervision fee in lieu of facilitating the Institute faculty as his/her Supervisor / Co-Supervisor. This fee will include fee for utilization of research facilities such as labs, library, Software's etc. to the Research Scholars on Saturdays only."

The SDPC strongly recommends removal of the aforementioned clause.

(12) SDPC discussed the recommendation of the DDPC of Department of Civil Engineering on the case of Ms. Priyanka Mishra (2019RCE08) regarding 'Semester Leave', It was also mentioned that student had already taken Semester Leave in the previous semester (Odd Semester, 2023-24).

The SDPC considered the case and resolved to recommend 'Semester Leave' for the current semester (Even Semester 2023-24) as per the Clause Nos. 5.2 of the "Ordinance of Doctoral Programme" on sympathetic grounds.
